Wressle Planning Decision

Union Jack Oil plc ("**Union Jack**" or the "**Company**"), an onshore oil and gas production and exploration company with a focus on production, exploration, development and investment in the United Kingdom hydrocarbon sector, notes that Egdon Resources PLC ("**Egdon**") has released an RNS regarding the planning decision by the North Lincolnshire County Council's Planning Committee in respect of the development of the Wressle Oil Field in North Lincolnshire licences PEDL180 and PEDL182.

Union Jack holds an 15% interest in both licences.

Egdon Resources plc (AIM:EDR) announces that the North Lincolnshire County Council's Planning Committee has today refused planning consent for the development of the Wressle Oil Field at Lodge Farm, Wressle, North Lincolnshire.

"We are very disappointed by the decision of the Committee that goes against the positive recommendation of their Planning Officer which was determined after an extensive and thorough review of our proposals

We will now take time to consider our options including the ongoing appeal process already underway."
